She takes photos of rubbish on the streets, uneven pavements, groups of youths, drunks, beggars etc. So that there is evidence that cannot be denied or disputed and there is never an excuse that the problem cannot be found and solved.

Then there is **Cllr Phoday Jarjussey** who is out and about in the ward with his pen and paper, jotting down things of concern that he then emails to the relevant department in the civic. He has the added bonus of actually living in Hayes Town so he's on the spot should anything occur and witnesses are needed.



Last but not least is **Cllr Mo Khursheed** who as the Leader of the Labour Group has an incredibly busy work load, but never the less spends at least 3 days a week in the ward, talking to residents and forwarding their problems direct to the civic. As Leader he has direct access to the Chief Executive of Hillingdon Council.

Tory Hillingdon Delivers 2-Star Performance

The Conservatives have run Hillingdon Council since 1998 and their record has been abysmal. The independent Audit Commission has judged the council's performance as follows:-

The Star rating ranges from 4 stars for Excellent performance to 1 star for poor performance
